GUIDELINES FOR TEAM SHOOT ENTRY

Date: April 30, 2022 Start time: 8:30 AM

ATA and/or SCTP rules will govern this shoot. These are available on the ATA and SCTP websites. It is the responsibility of all coaches and shooters to know these rules.

Entry fees are \$35. for targets, plus a \$5. daily fee to TNSCTP and \$5 ATA and TSTA to register the targets (if registered targets are desired).

Individual shooters who do not have a full squad or team may be entered and will compete for the Individual High Gun in their category.

Club opens for practice at 7:30 am, and practice will be open until the program begins at 8:30. Due to the number of entries we cannot have a practice trap once the program starts. Practice is \$5.00 per round.

All squads (teams of 5 shooters) must be pre-entered and pre-cashiered by April 24, 202. Changes allowed only for sickness or injury. There will be no refunds of entry fees, so coaches, please make sure you have a commitment from your shooters!

We will shoot 100 targets on a field: We ask that the shooters take 50 shells to the line, shoot the first 25, and then go immediately into the 2nd 25, with a 5 minute break after 50 targets.

Please be respectful of the shooters who are following your squad!!

Score sheets will have the shooters names printed on them in the position in which the coach entered them on the entry form. <u>Absolutely</u> no position change on the line. Any position change on the line may result in <u>disqualification</u> <u>of the entire squad</u>! Any changes must be made the morning of the shoot prior to the 8:30 AM start time. Be sure the shooters know they must start in the same position each time they start a new round. Each shooter will be asked to give their name when asked by the scorekeeper, at the beginning of their <u>first</u> 25 targets. Shoot Management reserves the exclusive right to make all final determinations of rule and program enforcements and any situations involving "disqualifications."

If you have a preferred starting time, please advise by April 24^{th t}. Shoot management will make all reasonable efforts to accommodate such noticed requests. *First registered will be first served*. The postmark of your entry forms will govern the assignment process. Please state your preferred starting times using Early ... Middle ... or Late (*See Entry Form*).

Each coach will be sent the starting times by April 28rd via email, provided the entries are received in a timely manner and the coaches provide an email address for such notification. Please plan to have the team here at least 1 hour before they are scheduled to shoot, preferably sooner. The starting bank will be drawn the morning of the shoot. Any team who is more than 10 minutes late for their starting time will be rescheduled after the last squad. If you are on an early squad, this could entail as much as a 6 hour wait. Others may move up if they are prepared to shoot. Please be considerate of those who follow you and be on time for your event.

Please advise your assistant coaches and parents that all coaches and/or parents must remain behind the 27 yard line. The team may be disqualified if a coach or parent moves closer. Gun malfunctions will be dealt with by qualified referees on the line. There will be NO exceptions. Shoot Management reserves the exclusive right to make all final determinations of Program or rules violations and any situations involving "disqualifications."

As a reminder, we cannot mix registered and non-registered shooters on the same squad. If your team wants to register the targets with the ATA, all members of the squad must be ATA members and must furnish us with an ATA number and evidence of paid membership for the 2020 target year. Shoot management will have ATA application forms available if a shooter wants, or needs, to renew or join the ATA the day of the shoot. The ATA fee is \$12 for the target year and can be paid here at the shoot.
